- Describe the location of the Himalayas.

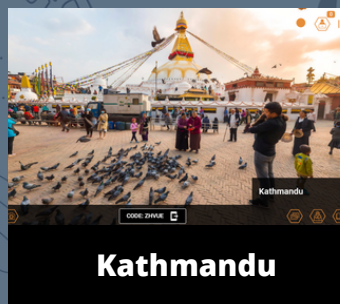
## Experience Description
