- Create a playlist by browsing content in your library or uploading content from your computer.
- Launch and guide lessons using any smart device including virtual reality goggles.
- Build immersive educational experiences using our Tour Creators.
- Create a class and give your students full access to our content and building tools.

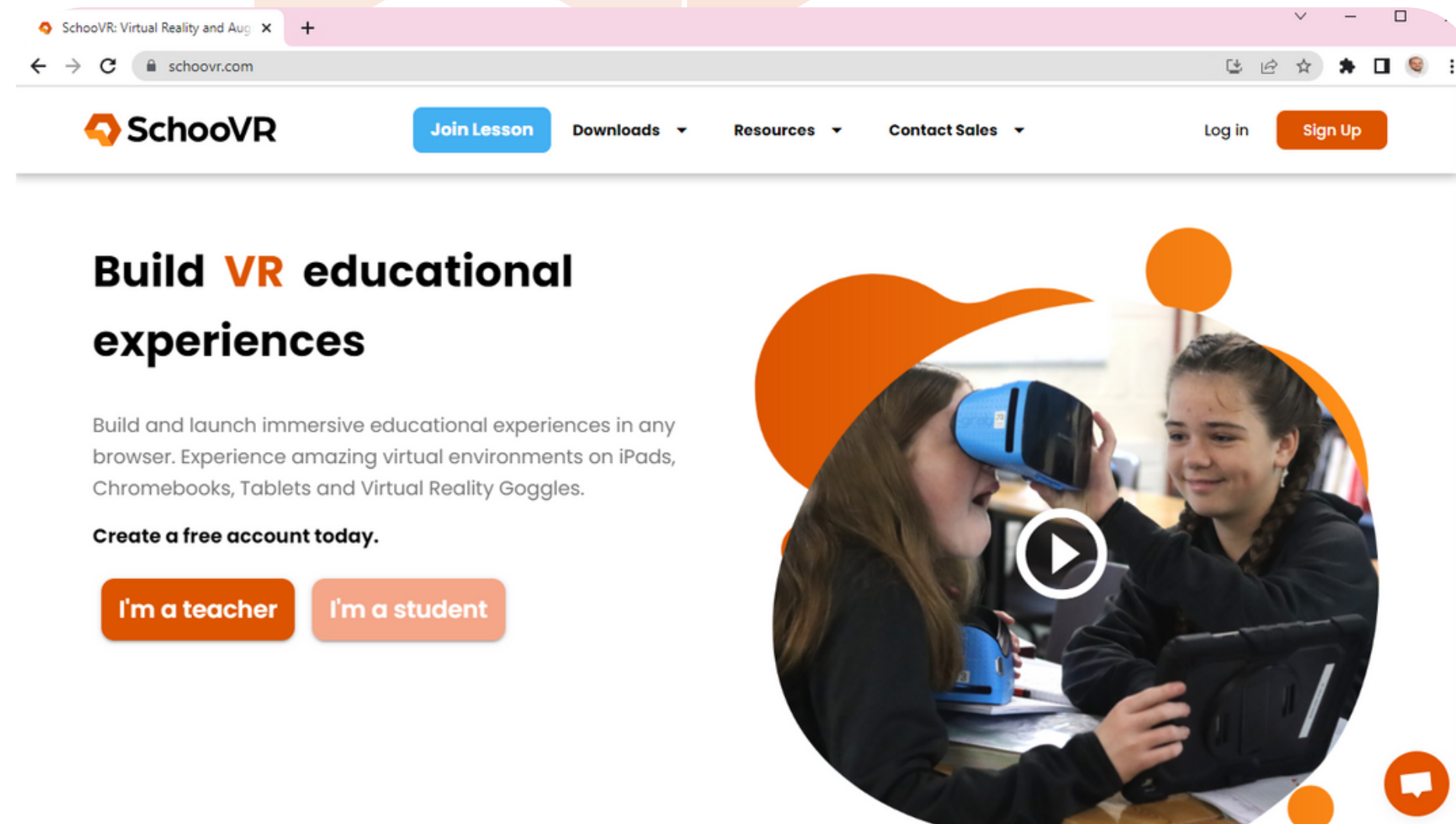

Logging in

- 1 Visit **www.schoovr.com** and click log in.

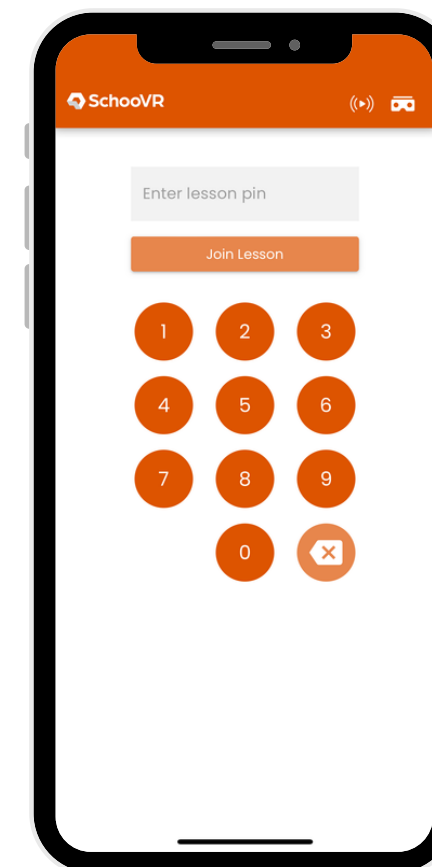


SchooVR homepage

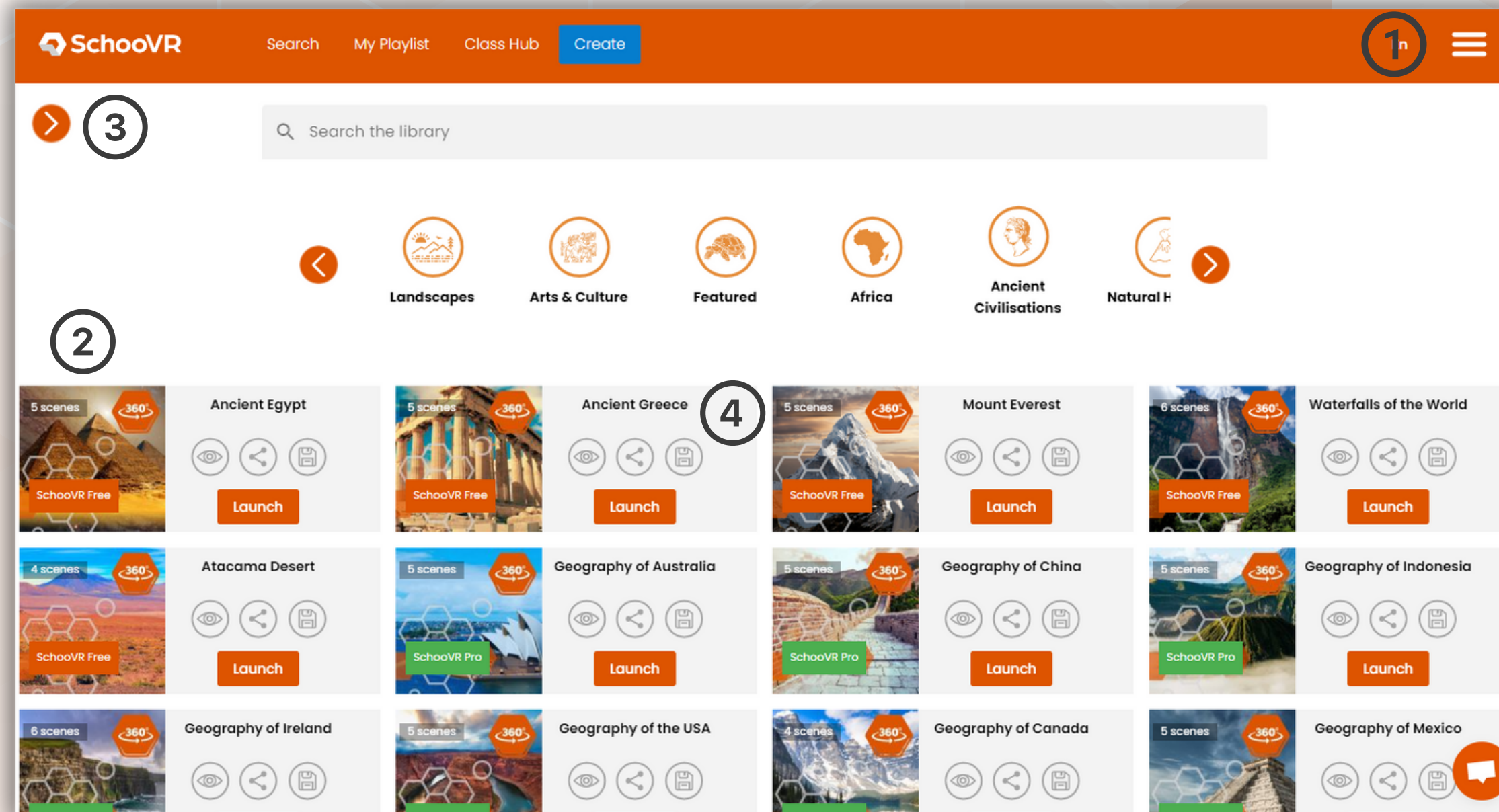

Planning a Lesson

Search our library

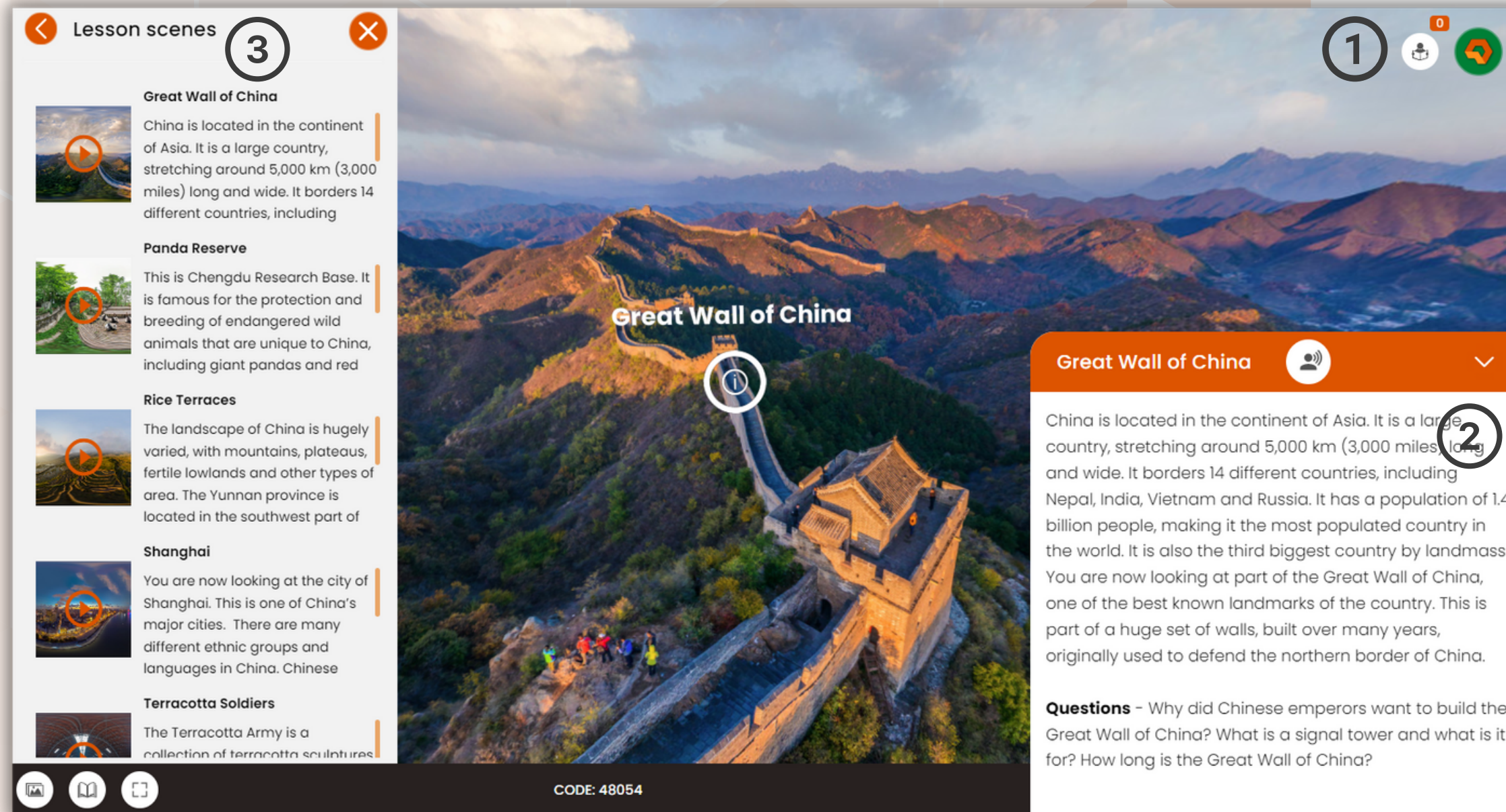


- ① This displays your account name. When selected, you can access your account, preferences, and logout.
- ② This is your content library. You will be able to see all the content available to you within this area.
- ③ You can use the Sort and Filter icon to narrow your search results. When selected, the List/Card View icon will toggle the layout of the content.
- ④ If you want to save content to your playlist, select the Save Lesson button.

Launch a lesson



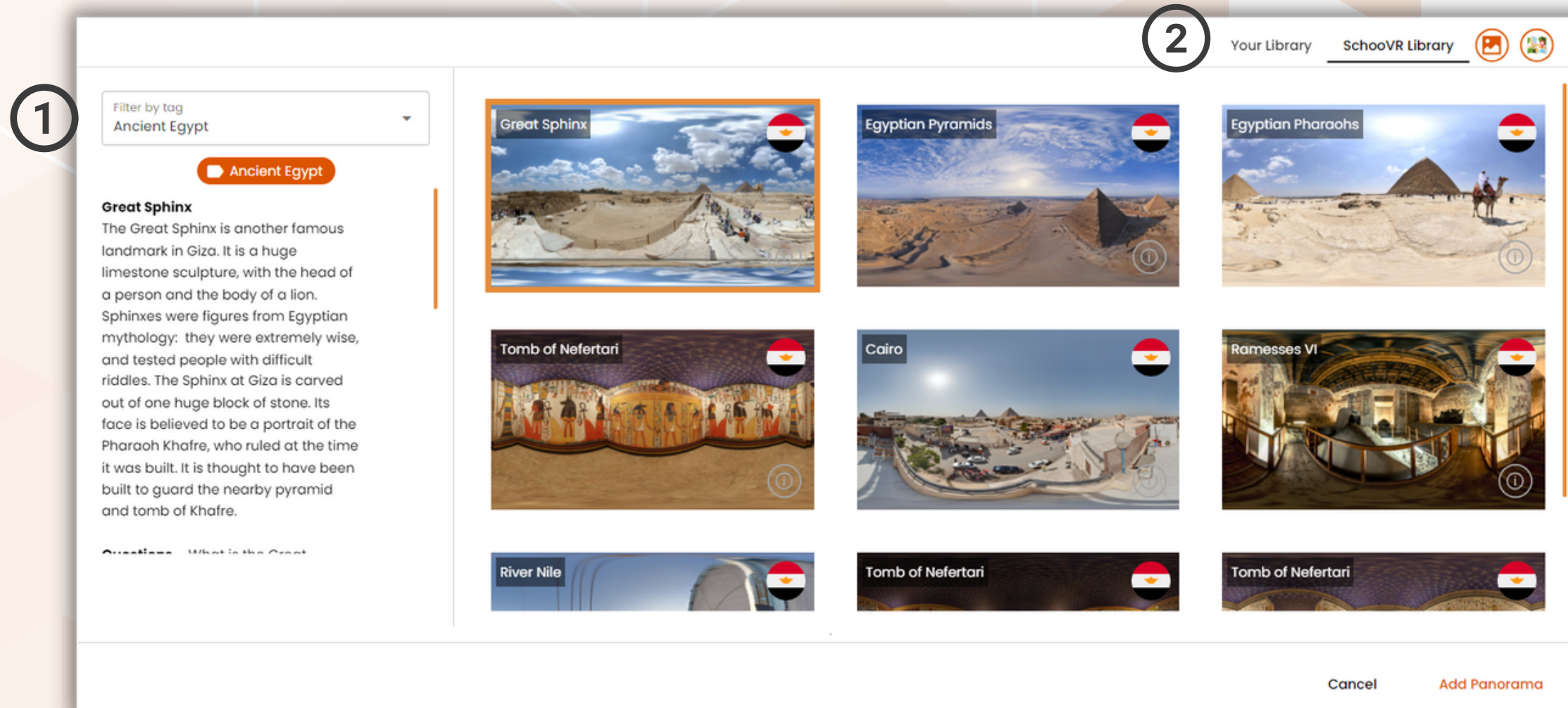
- ① This displays the students who have joined your lesson using the unique lesson code. Teachers can toggle teacher/student mode.
- ② This is the lesson content. Teachers can use the information to guide student learning. Guided audio can be selected here.
- ③ Teachers can browse several interactive scenes.
- ④ This loads the digital resources for the lesson. Teachers can send the resources in real time.

Students can access the lesson in the browser or using our Android or IOS viewer applications.

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Tour Builder

Select panoramas or videos

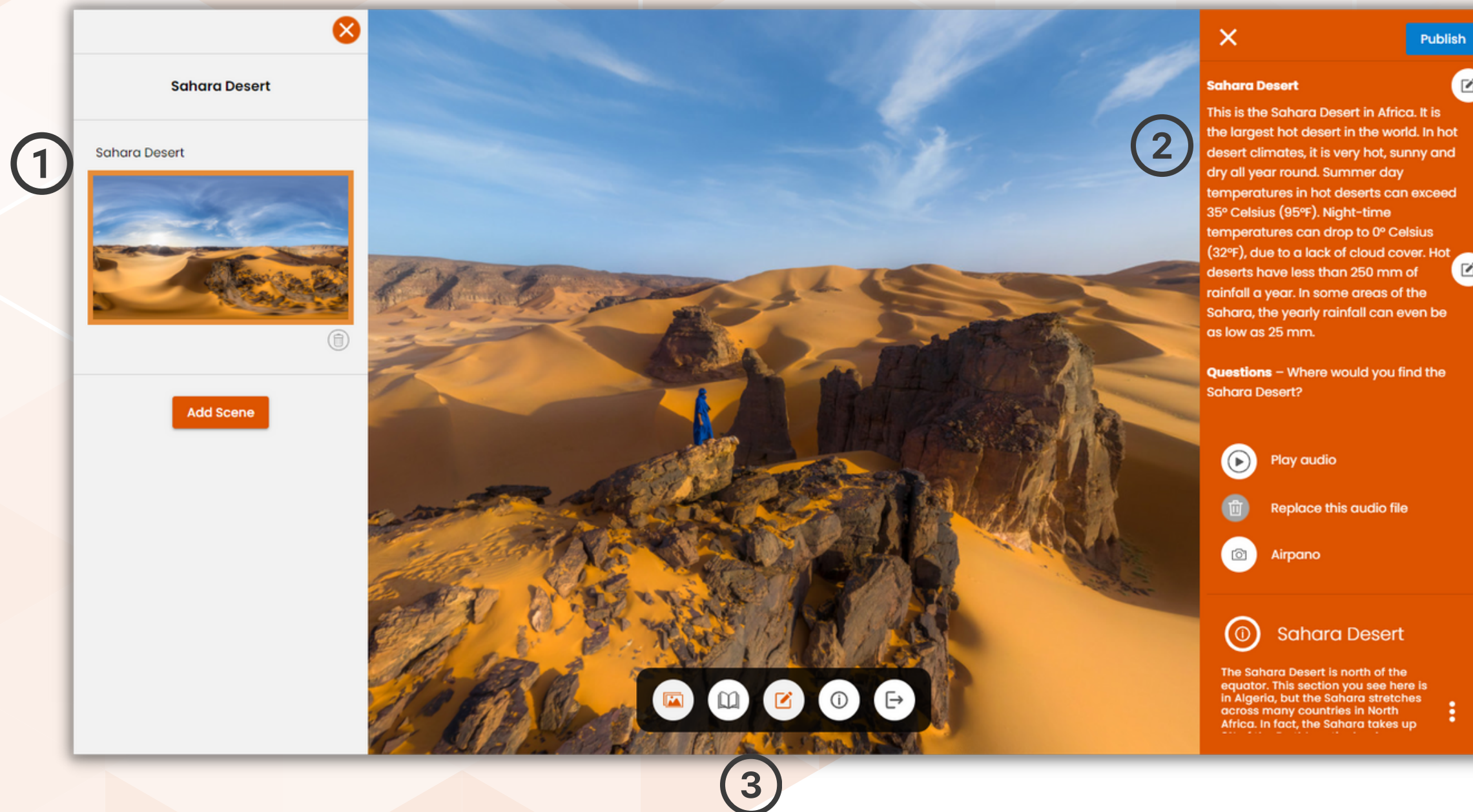


- ① Use the search bar to browse 1000s of panoramas.
- ② Select a panorama and add it to your tour. Upload your own images or videos using the uploader button.

Edit and publish

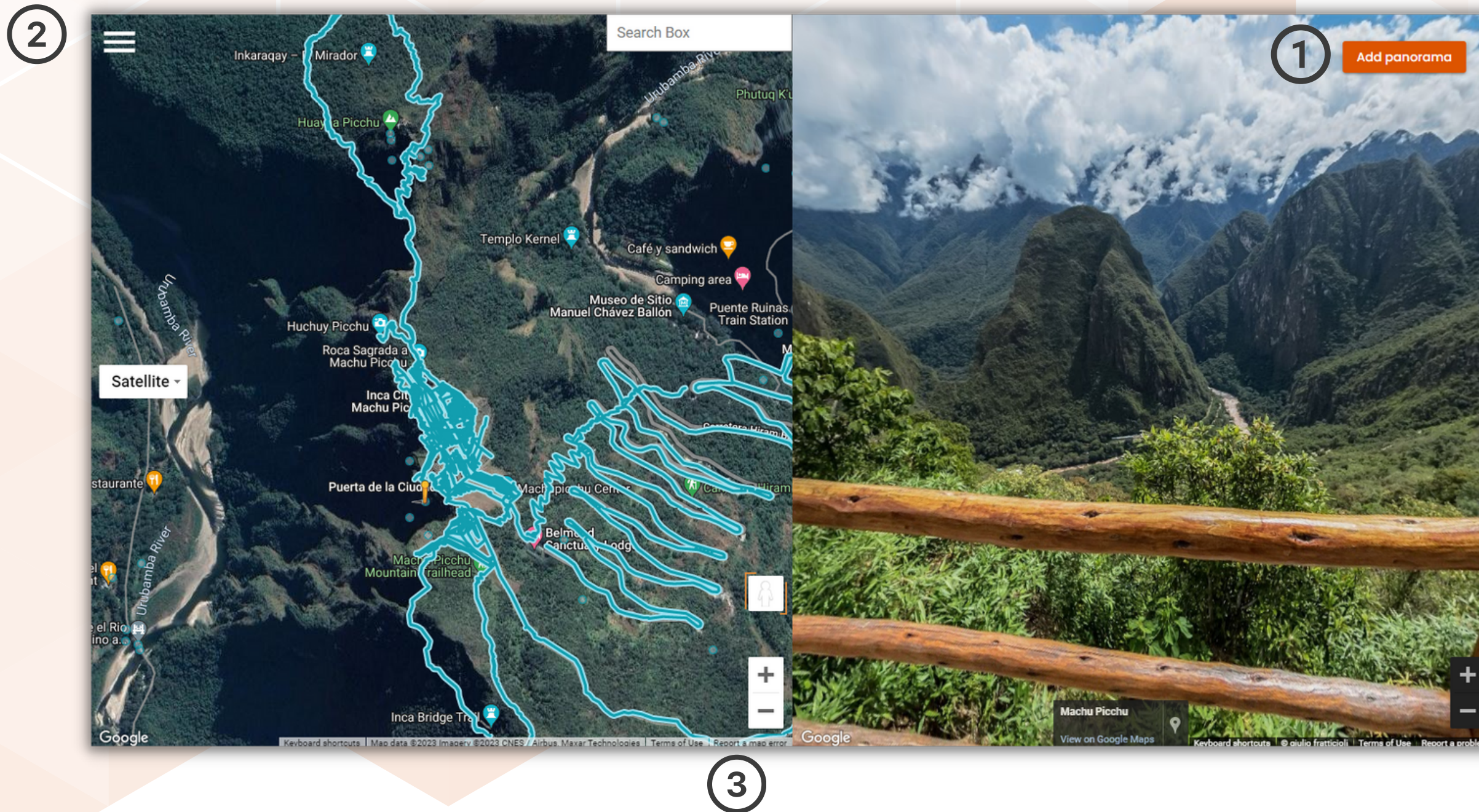


- ① This displays the panorama images and videos in each experience.
- ② Edit or add existing content. Add audio or a point of interest with interactive content.
- ③ Add several different resources including PDFs, PPTs, quizzes and slideshows.

Publish the experience and access it in your playlist at anytime.

- ① This enables members to add a panorama image.

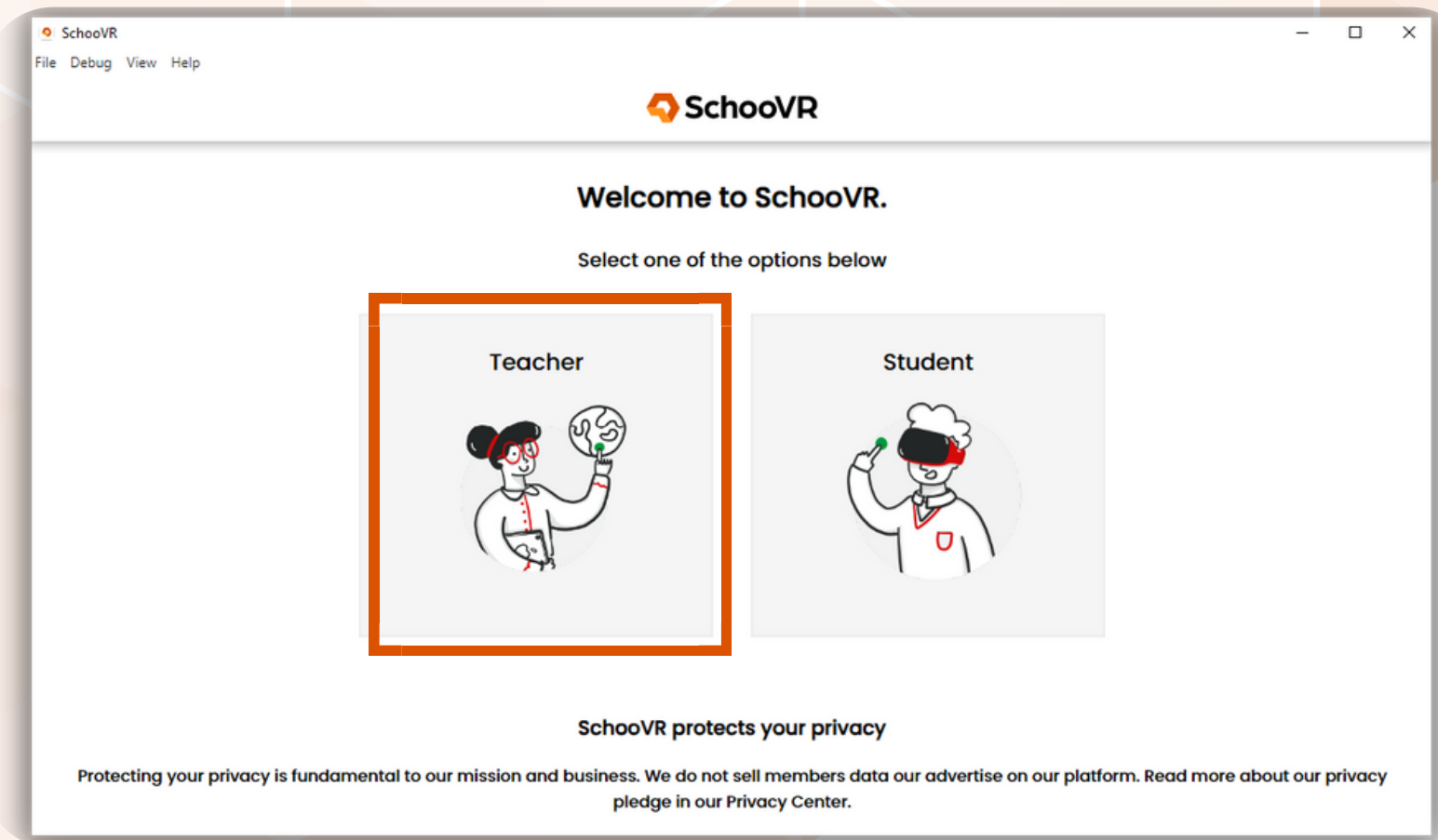
- 1 Select the **Class Hub** tab.

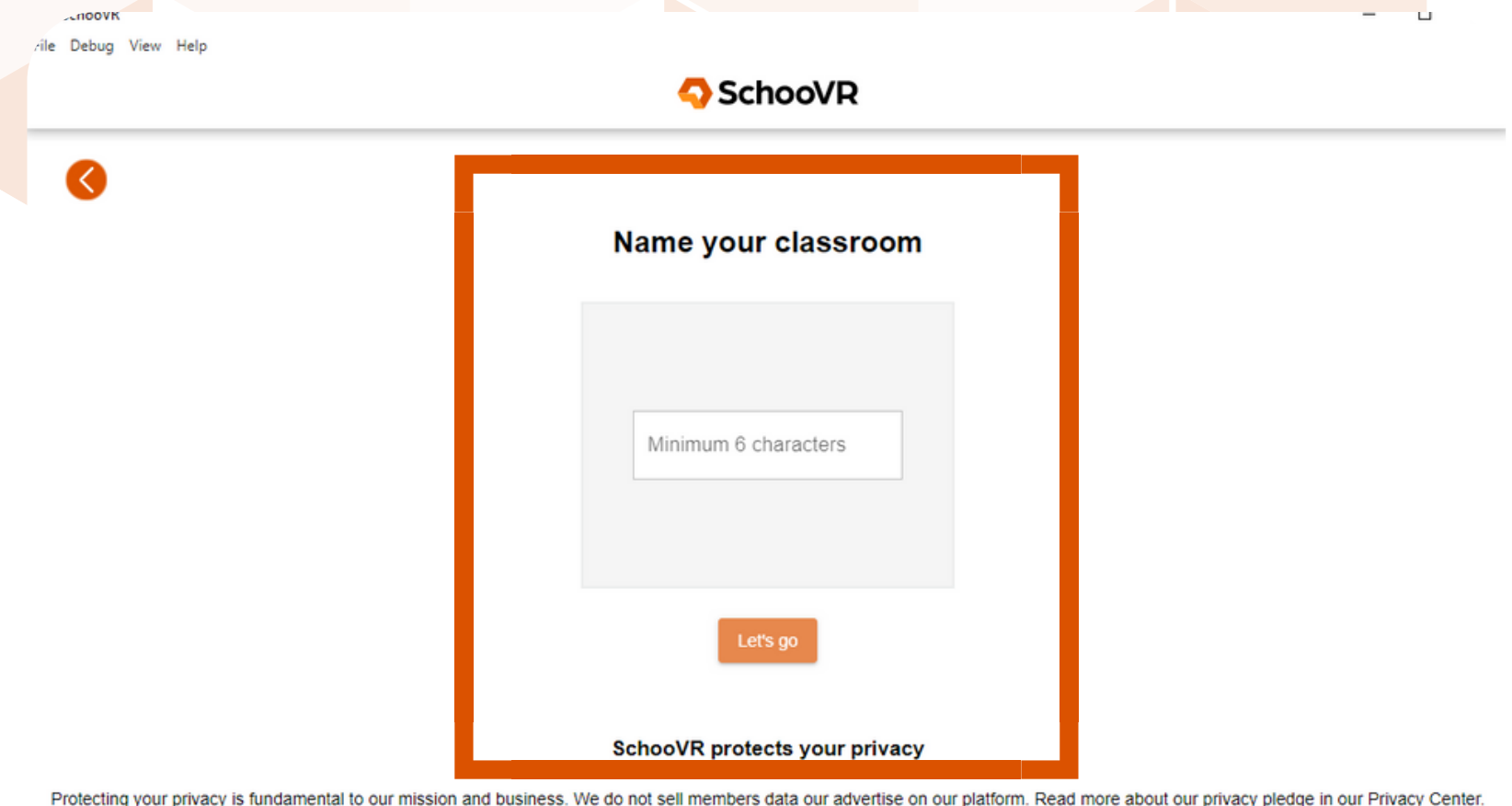
- ① Download SchooVR Software.

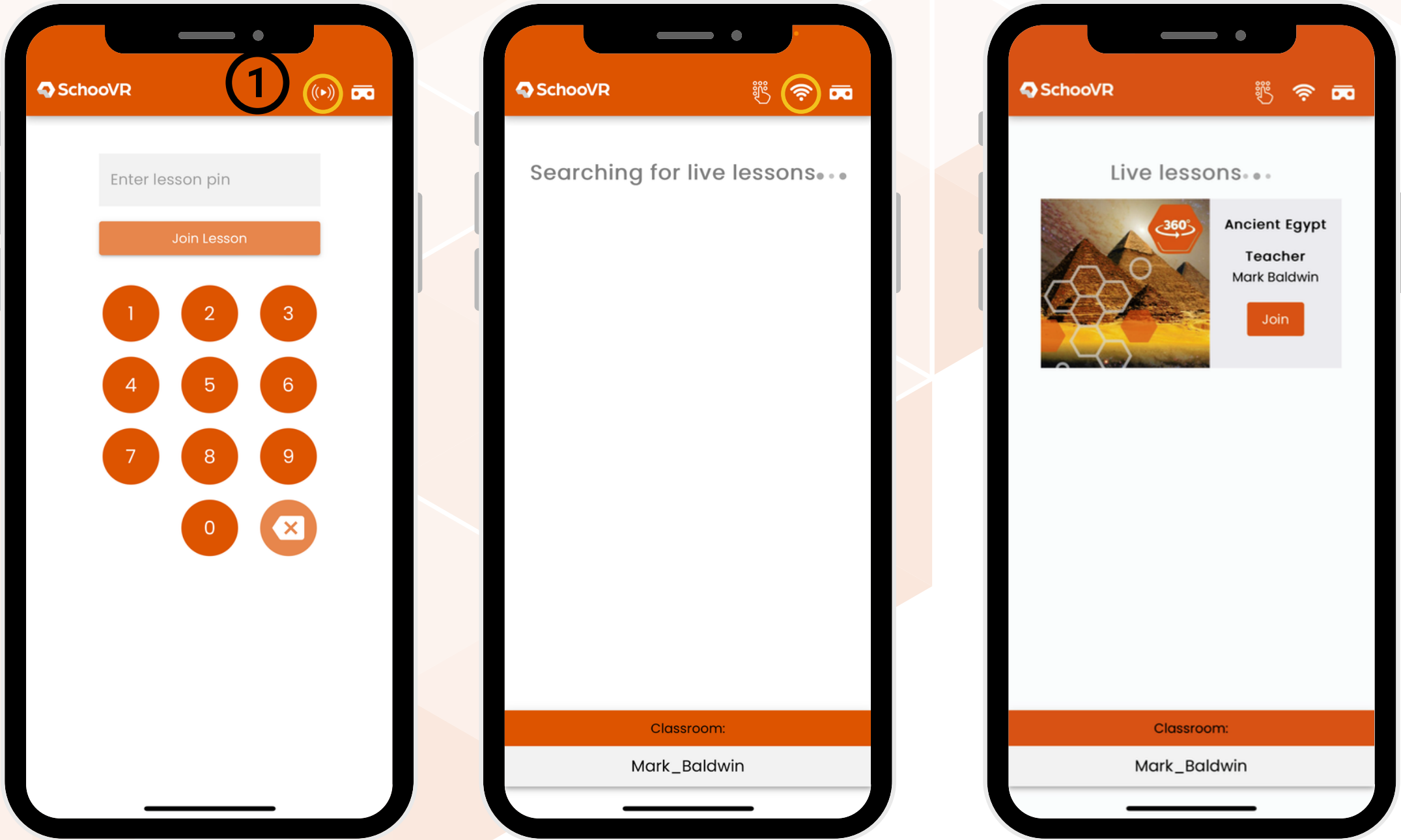
- ④ Log in using your account details.

- 1 Launch the student viewer application and press the live lesson icon in the top right hand corner of the application.
- 2 This displays the connected classroom.
- 3 Launched lessons appear under the live lesson tab. Students can join a lesson by selecting Join and entering their name.

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Virtual Reality Kits

Android and IOS kits

- ① Download the SchooVR viewer app from the Android or IOS store.
- ② Connect your device to a WiFi network or router and launch the app.
- ③ Place the device into a VR goggle and close the lid. Students can access the lesson by entering the unique lesson code and entering their name.
