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Overview

About SchooVR

SchooVR is a cloud-based WebXR platform that enables teachers and students to create immersive educational experiences on any device through browser-agnostic building tools. Utilizing the latest WebXR technology, it supports VR in the browser, making it accessible on a wide range of devices including Chromebooks, laptops, tablets, and DPVR headsets. SchooVR enhances classroom engagement, reduces teacher planning time, and provides an interactive and fun learning environment for students.

Getting Started

SchooVR is designed to enhance the classroom teaching experience with technology that is easy to manage. Users have the ability to:

- Create a playlist by browsing content in the library or uploading content from your computer.
- Launch and guide lessons using any smart device including DPVR headsets.
- Build immersive educational experiences using our Tour Creators.
- Create a class and give students full access to our content and building tools.

The Pro Wireless VR Headset is an all-in-one head-mounted virtual reality headset

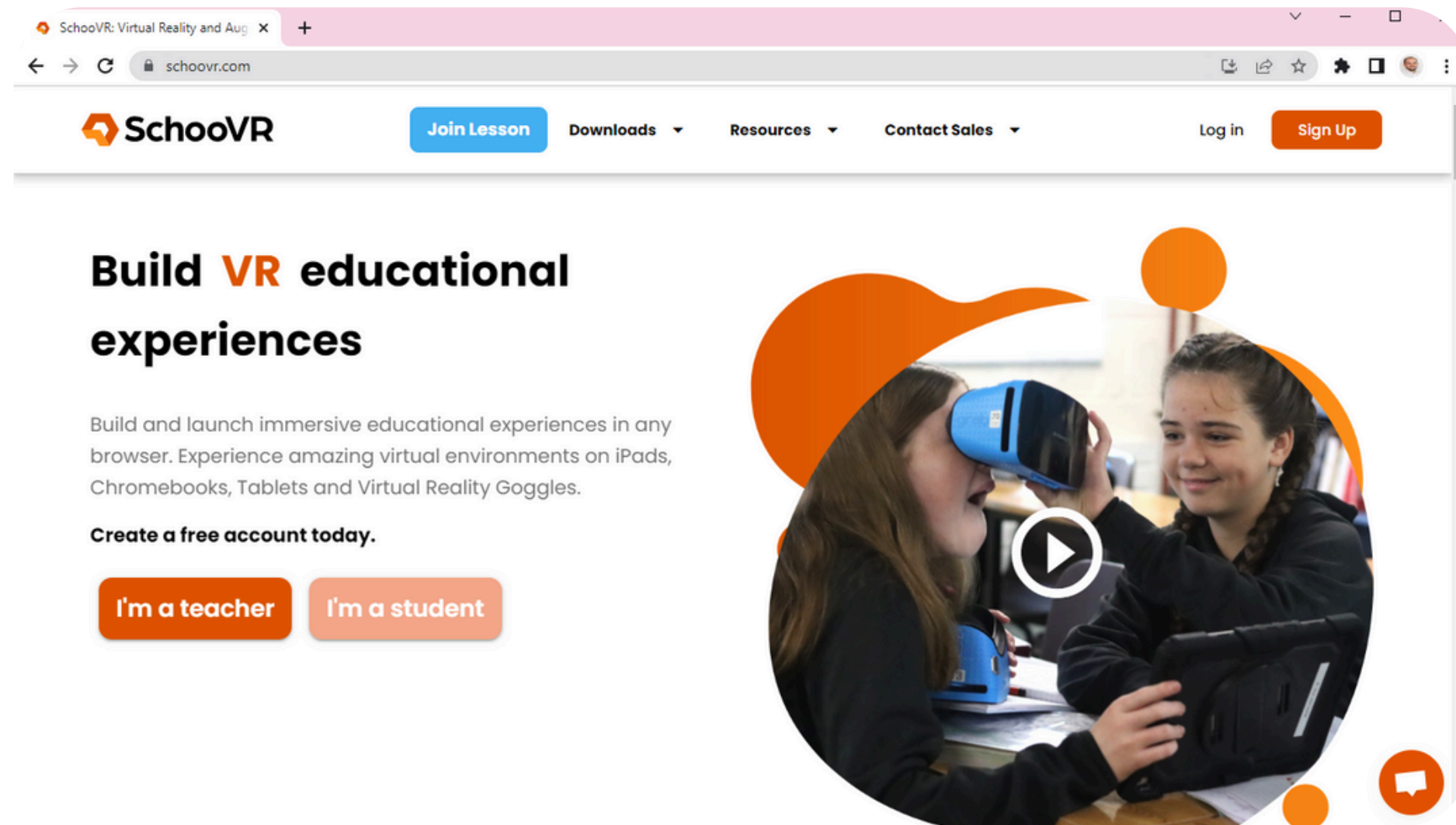

- 1 Visit www.schoovr.com and click log in.

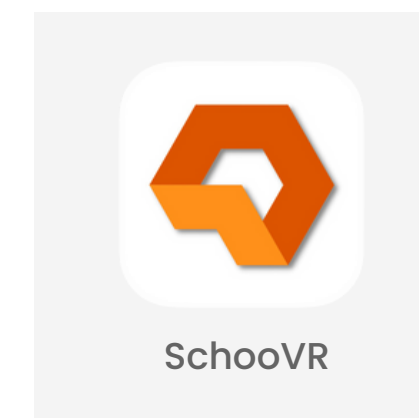


SchooVR homepage

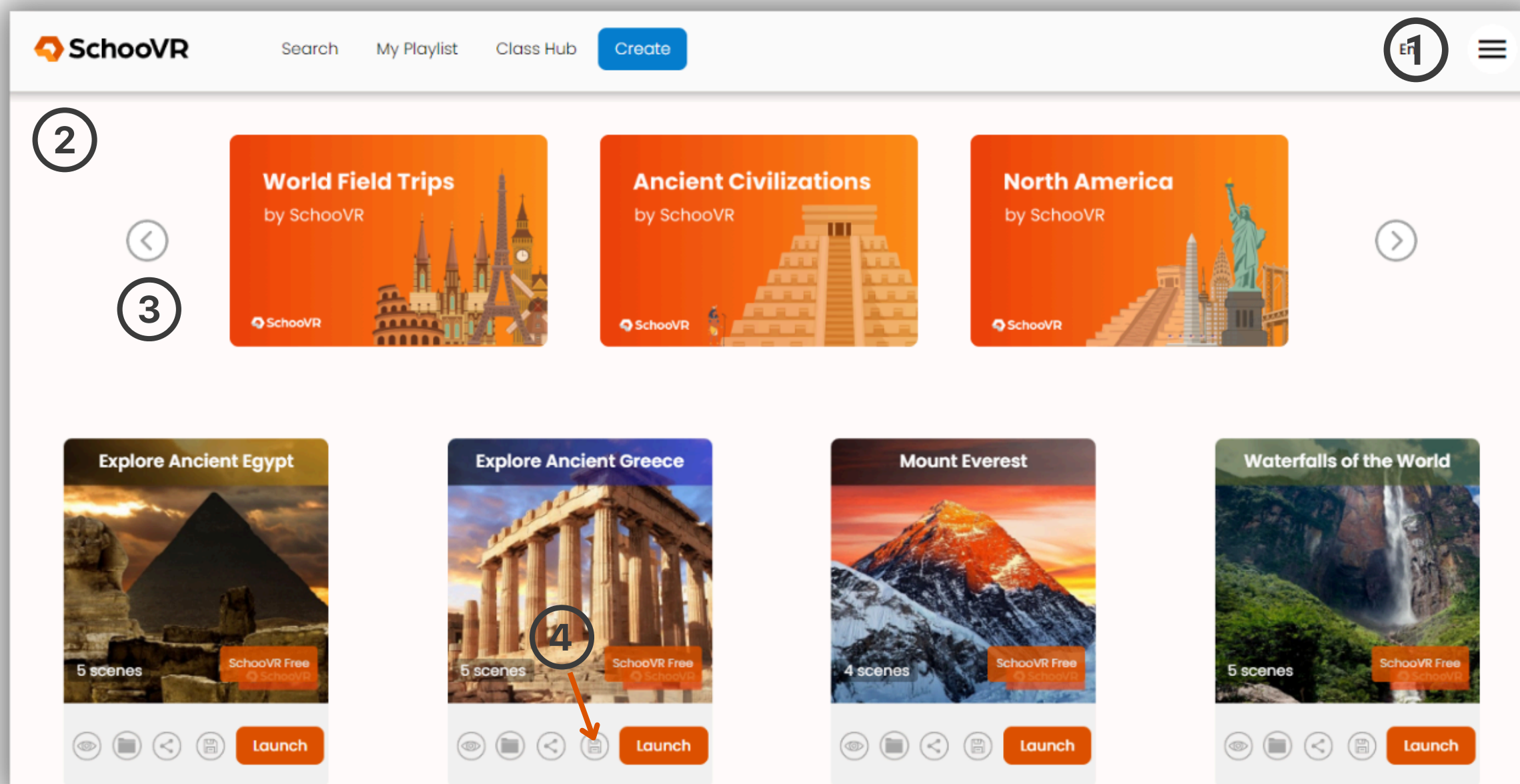
We suggest you bookmark the SchooVR Screen for easy access in the future.

Great Wall of China

China is located in the continent of Asia. It is a large country, stretching around 5,000 km (3,000 miles) long and wide. It borders 14 different countries, including Nepal, India, Vietnam and Russia. It has a population of 1.4 billion people, making it the most populated country in the world. It is also the third biggest country by landmass. You are now looking at part of the Great Wall of China, one of the best known landmarks of the country. This is part of a huge set of walls, built over many years, originally used to defend the northern border of China.

Questions - Why did Chinese emperors want to build the Great Wall of China? What is a signal tower and what is it for? How long is the Great Wall of China?

- 3 Teachers can browse several interactive scenes.
